

## PUBLIC NOTICE

### Hecate Energy Cider Solar, LLC

On June 7, 2022 Hecate Energy Cider Solar, LLC (“Hecate”) submitted an application to the New York State Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity under Section 68 of the Public Service Law (the “Petition”). Hecate is requesting an Order authorizing Hecate to own and operate the proposed Cider Solar Farm, an approximately 500 MW solar powered generation facility, to be located in the Towns of Elba and Oakfield, Genesee County, New York (“the Project”). Hecate also seeks an Order providing for lightened regulation.

Hecate is currently seeking a permit pursuant to Section 94-c of the New York Executive Law from the New York State Office of Renewable Energy Siting (“ORES”) in a separate proceeding, ORES Matter No. 21-01108, to construct and operate the Project. Hecate filed an application for such permit with ORES on June 3, 2021. ORES issued a Draft Permit to Hecate for the Project on March 1, 2022.

Hecate has requested that no hearing on the Petition be required and that the Commission decide the Petition based on the Petition, attachments thereto, and the record in the Section 94-c proceeding, ORES Matter No. 21-01108.
